 - 9. Investing in students' wellbeing; Decrease counselor ratio from 500:1 to 400:1. One social worker at every TUSD high school. P.E. teachers at all K-5, and K-8 schools.
 - 10. Empowering the next generation of TUSD Alumni; Adding 5, new full-day preschool classrooms. Providing a \$2,000 supply budget for every TUSD preschool teacher.
 - 11. Cultivating Future Achievements; Investment in high school graduation credit recovery at all TUSD high schools. Funding to support student attendance initiatives in all TUSD schools.
 - 12. Workforce readiness; 15 new instructional Specialists in Career & Technical (CTE) such as automotive, construction, HVAC, welding,

and culinary arts programs. Invest in four Career Coaches to help students navigate post-high school career paths.
