<p>STATEMENT OF PURPOSE</p> 	<p>Parent involvement is fundamental and necessary. This involvement directly correlates to student academic success. Staff members will encourage parent participation to support student learning. Parents of children attending Booth-Fickett shall have the opportunity to participate in the development and evaluation of Title 1 programs.</p>
<p>ANNUAL TITLE I MEETING</p> 	<p>At the beginning of each school year, schools and families will meet to share Title 1 budget information. This information will be available for new families throughout the school year.</p>
<p>ANNUAL EVALUATION</p> 	<p>The Booth-Fickett Site Council will verify annually the progress made towards achieving the goals and expected results of the school's Parent Involvement Policy and the effectiveness of the school compact.</p>
<p>FLEXIBLE MEETING TIMES AND LOCATIONS</p> 	<p>School personnel will provide a variety of meeting times and locations for the mentioned activities, as requested, to serve all families.</p>
<p>BUILDING OF ACADEMIC FAMILY INVOLVEMENT</p> 	<p>Booth-Fickett will provide parents opportunities to attend informational activities (academic workshops, and special projects). Appropriate language support is provided.</p>
<p>PARENTING</p> 	<p>Booth-Fickett will offer programs to assist families with various parental needs. Examples of this may include parenting and child raising skills, general education courses, English as a second language, and understanding adolescent development. This will assist parents in setting home conditions that support children as students at each age and grade level.</p>
<p>COMMUNICATION</p>	<p>Booth-Fickett will provide opportunities beyond parent-teacher conferences, to share information and encourage participation in their child's education. Parents will be provided assistance in understanding goals, assessments, monitoring and decision making to coordinate and participate in their child's educational success.</p>

	
<p>VOLUNTEER</p> 	<p>Volunteering at Booth-Fickett is welcomed and encouraged to create a partnership between families and the school.</p>
<p>LEARNING AT HOME</p> 	<p>Parents and students will be informed about grade level expectations and standards for performance, policies regarding homework, discipline, attendance, and other issues of importance. Booth-Fickett staff will provide tips and support for encouraging a positive learning environment at home.</p>
<p>DECISION MAKING</p> 	<p>Parents are offered meetings and services that will permit meaningful parent involvement in the decision-making process involving the school improvement plan and other programs that relate to the education of their child. Parents will be included as participants in school decisions and will be invited to all Site Council meetings and PTO meetings.</p>
